## SIX-PAK INDOOR CRICKET RULE VARIATIONS

1. Six players per team
2. 18 overs per innings
3. Each batting pair bats for 6 overs
4. Each player bowls 1 over to each batting pair
5. Court is divided into thirds by redlines - 2 fielders only in each third until bowler has released the ball
6. Minus 6 runs for a wicket
7. Batters can be caught off the back net if the ball hits the 13 square or the coke sign.
8. The scoring zones are higher (see diagram).
9. And the most important rule of all - the highest batting partnership for the game, regardless if you win or lose, receives a free six-pak of drinks from the bar/canteen.

### Scoring Zones

- A - 1 plus physical runs
- B - 2 plus physical runs
- C - 3 plus physical runs
- D - 4 on the bounce, 6 on the full plus physical runs

- E - white squares on back net - 12 plus physical runs but may be caught out (if caught, minus 6 runs)
- F - Coca Cola sign - 20 plus physical runs but may be caught out (if caught, minus 10 runs)
